Demonstrator – George Pastuch

THEME – Bowl Turning—Green/Wet Timber

Last month with Ron, we tried our hand at very thin stemmed goblets and flowers.

The 'thin' theme continues. WE will be turning thin walled bowls from green wet timber.

The end result is to achieve a bowl that moves as it dries creating some interesting shapes.

For the next three weeks you will need to harvest a bowl blank from a tree or limb recently cut down.

Preferably a pale timber (eg. Ash, fruit, pine etc.). The wetter the better.

Timber size requirements – 150 to 200mm dia x 50 to 75mm deep.

I will also explain rough turning bowls as a method to reduce drying time.
