Glen Kutchen bought in a snowman and some Christmas ornaments and also a photo of a family member who had painted and strung up the ornaments. George Pastuch had also brought in a Pot Pourri bowl that he had made and his wife Frankie had scroll sawed the insert. All in all it was a great day.
